FINES

Fines will apply up to \$500 if appliances, tires, fluorescent light fixtures, paints, stains or household hazardous chemicals are found in roll off containers, or any load dumped in C&D area or Transfer Station.

When do I set my Garbage & Recycling Out?

No Permanent Solid Waste Container shall be kept or maintained in a front yard, except for collection - Residential solid waste receptacles or containers shall **not** be placed at the curb more than 12 hours before the scheduled time of collection and shall be removed from the curb promptly following collection.

Containers need to be stored on private property and not City right-of-way.
